Thank you for displaying a collection tin for the Ménière's Society. As well as fundraising, it also raises awareness of our organisation and the work we do.



Collection boxes at home

Everyone has small change down the back of the sofa! Why not keep a collection box on the side at home and pop in the ones you find! You'll be amazed how quickly it fills up!

Collection boxes at work, school or GP surgery

Why not put a collection box in your business or school office and encourage your colleagues to donate. We may even be able to claim back Gift Aid on the amount raised in each collection tin through the *Gift Aid small donation scheme*. If you are placing your collection box at work, please remember to put your organisation address on the *Authorisation Form*. You'll need written permission from the manager, or other authorised person. You may want to include a copy of their authorisation letter when you return our authorisation form to us.



Collection boxes in public places

You will need permission and/or a licence to collect money in a public place, in the street or door-to-door. Contact your local council for more information and bear in mind it may take a little while to process an application for a licence. You must be over 16 to collect money in public.

Checking your tin

Check your collection tin regularly to ensure the seal is still intact, it's in good condition and if it needs emptying. All our tins are provided with security chains.

Emptying your collection tin

When opening the tin, please do so in the presence of a witness. Please complete the *Income Form* in full, entering the total amount collected. Both you and the witness should print and sign your names.
